# SKATE RENTAL REGULATIONS KONESER

**Below are a few rules and regulations that we have introduced to ensure the common safety of both our guests and employees. Please familiarize yourself with the following regulations before entering.**

1. Skates are rented with a deposit of 50 PLN for 1 pair of skates.
2. It is also possible to rent skates based on a written declaration confirmed by a valid photo ID, while adhering to the conditions specified in this regulation:
  - a. The renter consents to the processing of personal data in accordance with the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of April 27, 2016, on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation), i.e., the right of access, correction, and deletion of your personal data, the right to limit their processing, the right to transfer them, the right not to be subject to automated decision-making, and the right to object to the processing of your personal data.
  - b. The administrator of personal data processes personal data based on the consent given. The renter's data is processed within the scope and purpose specified in the content of the consent. In connection with the processing of personal data, in case of non-return or destruction of the leased equipment, the recipients of personal data may be public authorities and courts.
  - c. Personal data will be stored for the duration of the rental service and, in the case of non-return or damage to the rented equipment, for the period necessary to pursue related claims.
  - d. The renter has the following rights regarding the processing of personal data: - the right to access personal data
    - the right to request correction (rectification of personal data)
    - the right to request deletion of personal data (right to be forgotten)
    - the right to request limitation of the processing of personal data
    - the right to withdraw consent at any time.
  - e. In case the renter obtains information about unlawful processing of personal data, the renter has the right to file a complaint with the relevant data protection supervisory authority.
3. The rental fee must be paid according to the current price list.
4. Skates are rented only for the duration of one session/class.
5. Failure to return the skates after the end of the session/class will result in a charge for each started hour according to the price list applicable for standard skate rentals.
6. Additional charges will apply for lost or damaged skates, based on the current market price of new skates.
7. Skates must be returned cleaned of snow and with the insoles placed in plastic boots.
8. Skates should be returned as soon as possible after the end of the session/class.
9. Both when renting and returning skates, queues must be observed.
10. Skate replacements are conducted out of order.
11. Walking in skates on surfaces not suitable for this purpose (e.g., concrete) is prohibited.
12. Every user of the rental service is obliged to familiarize themselves with the above regulations and adhere to its principles.
